COMMUNITY BEAUTIFICATION GROUP SEEKS VOLUNTEERS

Planting Irondequoit Pride is placing an open call out to any residents with a desire to help keep Irondequoit a beautiful place to live. The all-volunteer organization will be having a meeting on Thursday, September 6th at 6:30 in the Town Hall first floor conference room.

Organized in September 2006 by Supervisor Mary Ellen Heyman and Councilwoman Debbie Evans, *Planting Irondequoit Pride* works hard to boost civic pride in Irondequoit through town-wide litter cleanup drives and beautification projects that include:

- Planting and maintaining three flower gardens (East Ridge Road, Kings Highway, and St. Paul & Pattonwood) and planting and maintaining flowers around eight "Welcome to Irondequoit" signs;
- Planting and caring for flower planters along five main intersections of East Ridge Road
- Crafting and installing Winter wreaths along five main intersections of East Ridge Road
