The validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Irondequoit, Monroe County, New York is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

### SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Irondequoit on October 27, 2020.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF IRONDEQUOIT, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$350,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO UNDERTAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN’S CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT”.

2. The specific object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the financing of certain improvements to the Town of Irondequoit Consolidated Sewer District (the “District”) consisting of the upgrade and replacement of the Fox Hall Pump Station (collectively, the “Project”).

3. The period of probable usefulness is 30 years.

4. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$350,000.

The resolution summarized herein shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the offices of the Town Clerk, Town of Irondequoit, Town Hall, 1280 Titus Avenue, Rochester, New York 14617.
